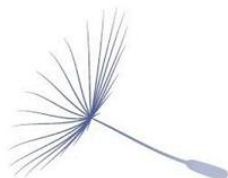

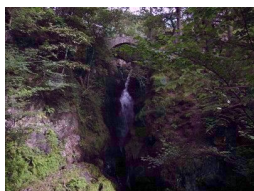

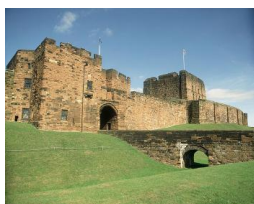


National Trust run waterfall on the western side of Ullswater in the Lake District. Superb walk to the waterfall in an enchanted woodland. Toilets and café on site.

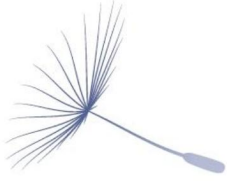
